## Norfolk Washcloth

Skill level: intermediate





### What you will need:

Bernat Handcrafter Cotton in white or other similar weight yarn.

Crochet hook H (5mm)

Your label (optional)

This crochet pattern is in USA terminology.

### Size

Approx. 8" (20cm) square



# Norfolk Washcloth

Make this cotton washcloth as a quick intermediate project.

### **DIRECTIONS**

**Pattern Note:** The pattern is created from 2 FPdc, 2 BPdc and every row it moves over one stitch to form a diagonal pattern.

### **WASH CLOTH**

Foundation: Chain 21.

**Row 1:** Chain 2, 1 dc in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch from hook, 1dc in every stitch (21 sts).

Row 2: 2ch, 1 FPdc, \*2 BPdc, 2 FPdc \*, rep from \* to \* [4] times, 2 BPdc, 1FPdc.

Row 3: 2ch, \* 2 BPdc, 2 FPdc \*, rep from \* to \* [4] times, 2BPdc, 1FPdc.

Rows 4 - 13: Continue in diagonal pattern for 13 rows.

### **BORDER**

Row 1: \* 3ch, skip 2 sts, 1dc in gap \*, repeat from \* to \* to corner st, 3ch 1dc 3ch 1dc in corner st, continue round the border making, 3ch 2dc, in each corner stitch, join with ss.

Row 2: 2dc in every 3ch loop to end.

Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave ends up and down along the edge and *not* into the body of the work.

Neatly sew in your label (optional).

### **ABBREVIATIONS**

**ch** = chain(s), **ss** = slip stitch; **sc** = single crochet; **dc** = double crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.

**FPdc** = front post double crochet;

**BPdc** = back post double crochet.
