What you will need:

Red Heart Boutique
Unforgettable 2 balls or similar
weight yarn.

Crochet hook H (5mm)

Your label (optional)

Size

Top edge 80" (200cm),
side edges 45" (120cm).



Lancashire shawl

*Make this beautiful lightweight shawl
as an easy beginner's project.*



DIRECTIONS

Notes

Change balls of yarn at the edges
and not in the middle of a row.

Shawl is worked from the point
up to the wide top.

Row 1: 3 ch (as edge stitch), 3 dc
in 3rd ch from hook, 1 more dc
in same stitch (as edge stitch).

Row 2: 3 ch, 3 dc in first gap
between 1st 2 dc's on row 1, 5 ch,
4 dc in last gap between last 2 dc
on row 1.

Row 3: 3 ch, 3 dc in 1st gap, * 5
ch, sc in 5 ch loop*, repeat from
* to * until last loop, 4 dc in last
gap.

Row 4 to 7: Repeat row 3.

Row 8: 3 ch, 3 dc in 1st gap, *5
ch, sc in 5 ch loop*, repeat from
* to * 3 times, 3 dc in valley of
loops below, * 5 ch, sc in 5 ch
loop *, repeat from * to * 3 times
more, 4 dc.

Row 9: Repeat rows 7 and 8 to
form pattern. Work 69 rows or
until yarn is nearly finished.

Row 70 or last row: 3 ch, 3 dc in
1st gap, * sc, 3 dc in the sc in the
valley of loops below* repeat
from * to * across the top of the
shawl to last 3 sts, sc, 4 dc in last
gap. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave ends up and down along
the edge and *not* into the body of
the shawl. Neatly sew in your
label 6" (15cm) from the end
point on the long top side.

ch = chain(s), **ss** = slip stitch; **sc**
= single crochet; **dc** = double
crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); [] =
work directions in brackets the
number of times specified; * =
repeat whatever follows the * as
indicated.
